DANO

DanO is a traditional Korean holiday marking the end of the spring sowing season. It is traditionally celebrated with the song, dance and games in Korea. GKF celebrates DanO with a lecture given by expert in Korean Arts and Culture at the Saint Louis Art Museum in partnership with the Museum. On the following day GKF presents a panel discussion on Korean art in cross cultural context followed by a fundraising dinner.

CHUSEOK

Chuseok is a major holiday in Korea celebrating good harvest. Traditionally, Korean families visit their ancestral hometowns and enjoy song, dance and games. It is also a time to have a feast.GKF celebrates Chuseok with many cultural activities such as games, martial arts and crafts as well as demonstrating the Korean Alphabet and calligraphy provided by local community members as well as by invited, well known performers from the US or South Korea. GKF also shares an array of Korean Food.
